What to Expect

- ◆ Participate in a live burn—a flexible event date allows us to find the best burn day based on weather conditions.
- ◆ Learn prescribed burn techniques to use on your own land.
- ◆ Learn about a prescribed burn plan, smoke management, fire weather, liability laws, financial resources, and burn permits.
- ◆ Ideal participants are landowners/ land managers with minimal to no prescribed fire experience.
- ◆ Participants are required to sign a waiver on the day of the event.
- ◆ Participants must expect to be active most of the day, walking on uneven ground and using/carrying tools.
- ◆ Participants must wear all-natural fiber clothing (cotton, linen, wool) or fire-retardant pants and shirts. Leather boots are preferred.
- ◆ Participants are encouraged to bring eye protection and leather gloves. Items will be provided if needed.
