## WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Participate in a live burn
- Learn prescribed burn techniques that you can use on your own land.
- Learn about writing a burn plan, smoke management, fire weather, liability laws, financial resources, and burn permits.
- Ask questions to experienced professionals
- Ideal participants are landowners/ land managers with minimal to no prescribed fire experience.
- Participants are required to sign a waiver on the day of the event.
- Participants must expect to be active most of the day, walking on uneven ground and using/ carrying tools.
- Participants must wear all natural fiber (cotton, linen, wool) or fire retardant pants and shirts. Leather boots are preferred.
- Participants are encouraged to bring eye protection and leather gloves. Items will be provided if needed.
